Example 1: T-Shirt Mockup



Introduction to Layers

Pixpine logo layer and you can delete or hide it.

This folder contains different effects and we don't recommend editing.

This folder contains Highlights and Shadows of the product mockup.

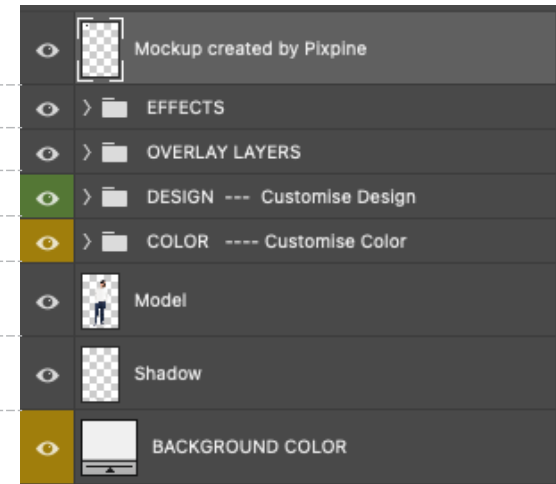
This folder contains all the Smart Object layers where you put your artwork.

This folder contains color palettes to change the color of different parts of the mockup.

Base layer of the product mockup.

Transparent shadow of the product mockup.

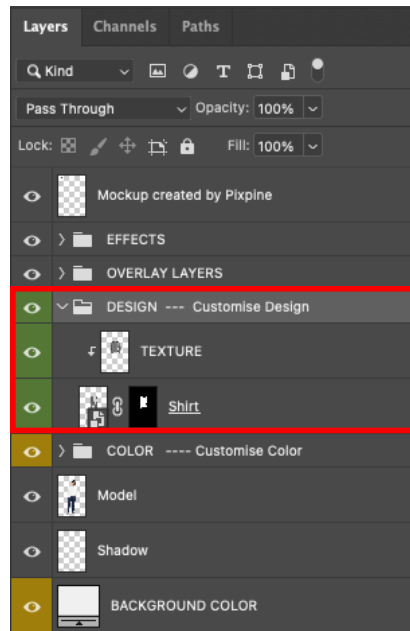
With the help of this layer you can change background color.



Tips: Green colored layers are to replace your design
Yellow colored layers are to change mockup color

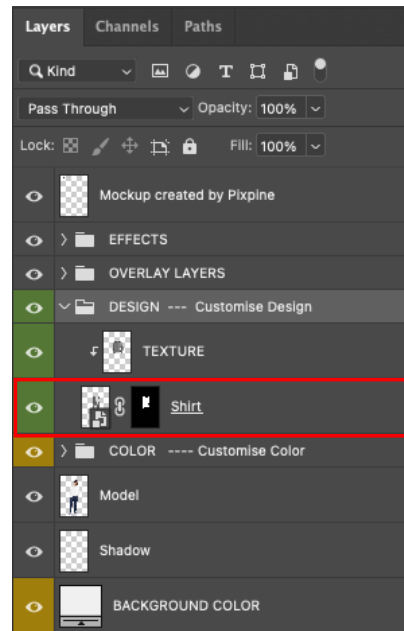
How to replace your design?

Step 1:



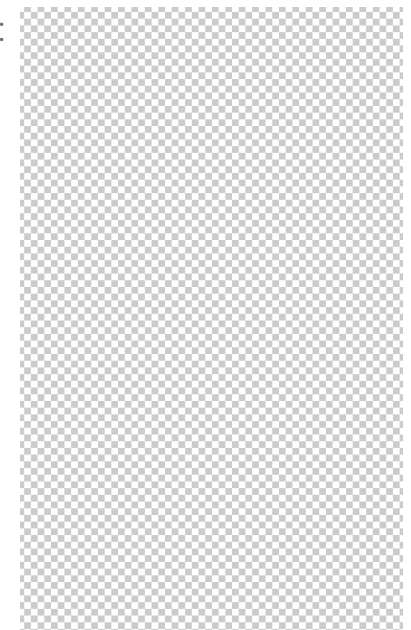
Once you open the file, expand the folder "Design ---- Customise Design"

Step 2:



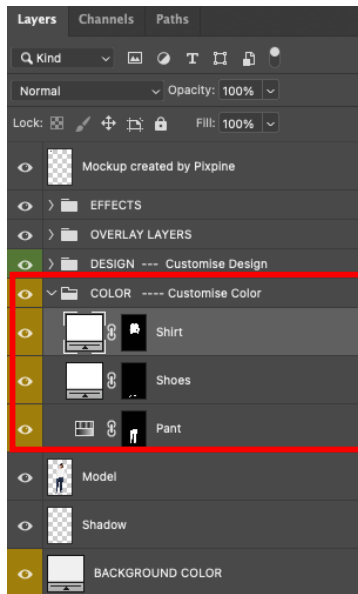
Double click on the Smart Object layer "Shirt", tagged with green color

Step 3:



A new window will pop up, drag and drop your design and save it.

How to change color?



1. Expand the "COLOR---- Customise Color" folder
2. Click on any color palette to change the color of "Shirt" or "Shoes"..

To change the color of "Pant", double-click on the layer and change to your desired color.

Example 2: Bottle Mockup



Introduction to Layers

Pixpine logo layer and you can delete or hide it.

This folder contains two different types of bottle cap

Turn On/Off the folder layer to select the desired cap type.

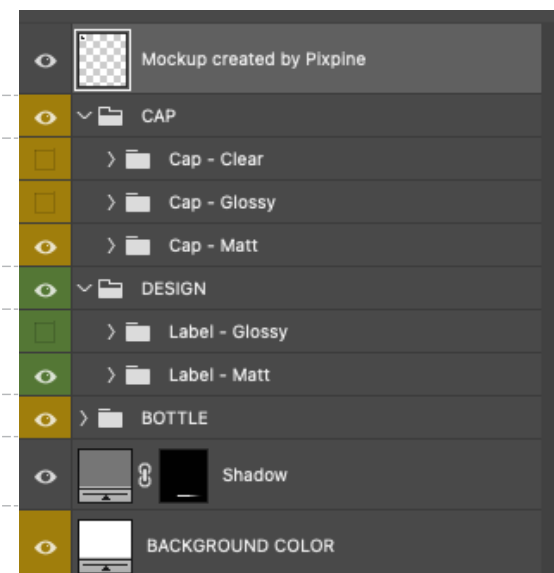
This folder contains two different types of bottle label Glossy & Matt

Turn On/Off the folder layer to select the desired label type.

This folder contains bottle layers to edit color

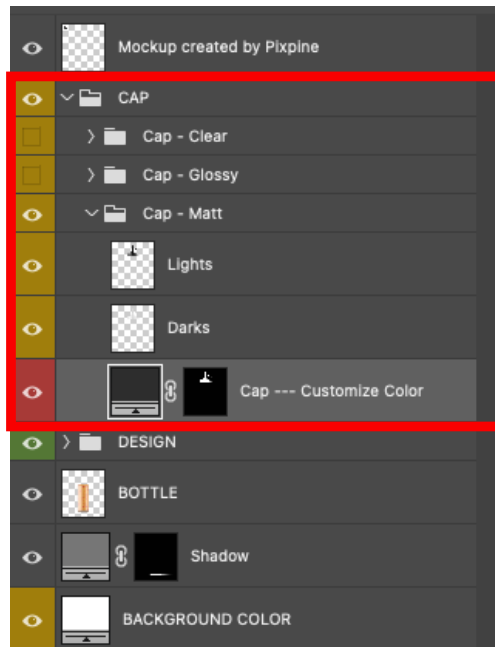
Bottle shadow layer, to select light or dark tone

With the help of this layer you can change background color.



How to change color?

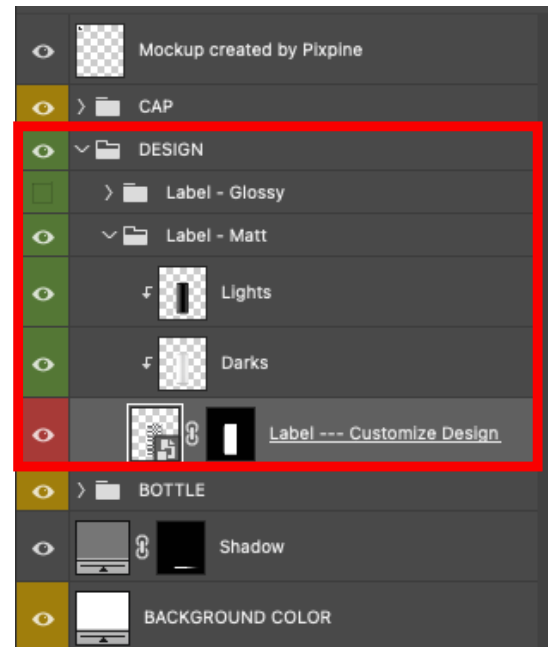
Step 1:



1. Once you open the file, expand the folder "CAP".
2. Turn On/Off the folder layer to select the desired cap type (glossy/matt).
3. Expand that desire folder and click on color pallate to change the color of cap.

How to replace your design?

Step 2:



1. Expand the Design folder and select type of label you want (Glossy/Matt).
2. Double click on the smart object layer which tagged in Red color.
3. A new window will pop up, simply drop your design and hit save.

Tip: To change the label color, create a new color layer inside the smart object.
